### Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 851 amends Nebraska Revised Statute 81-1210.02 by increasing the number of companies eligible for internship grants and by removing a provision regarding telecommuting.

Section 1 increases the number of companies eligible for internship grants from less than 50 full-time equivalent employees to less than 150 full-time equivalent employees.

The section also removes a subsection allowing students to telecommute if the business is located more than 30 miles from the college, university, or other institution of higher education where the student is enrolled and if the higher education institution is located within Nebraska.

### **Explanation of amendments:**

AM 2207 replaces the subsection's removal and edits the subsection to reflect the bill's intent to allow telecommute opportunities throughout the state of Nebraska.
