Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB898 would enact the National Crime Prevention and Privacy Compact. The Compact requires criminal history record information databases to be organized to a particular standard and accessible to the federal government and other party states for noncriminal justice purposes, such as employment background checks.

The Compact was signed into federal law in 1998 and as of July 2023, 35 states have ratified the Compact.
