## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Section 1: Amends Section 71-5905 to prohibit assisted-living facilities from requesting or requiring a third-party guarantee of payment as a condition of admission or continued stay in the facility. If a third-party wants to guarantee payment of a resident's expenses, a separate written agreement shall be executed. Such a separate written agreement must contain the three specific statements quoted in this section.

Section 2: Repeals original section.

## **Explanation of amendments:**

AM2857 adds the clarification that a facility may request and require a third-party who has legal access to a resident's income to sign a contract to provide payment from the resident's income. The third-party does not incur personal financial liability by signing such a contract.
