Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Section 43-1311.03(9) requires the Department of Health and Human Services to provide certain documents, information, records, and other materials when the child is leaving foster care. LB945 would amend this section to require DHHS to provide additional documents, information, records, and material.

A copy of the child's medical records must already be provided, but LB945 would specifically include psychological care and evaluations and a list of health care providers. A copy of educational records must already be provided, but LB945 would specifically include awards, certificates, and grade reports.

LB945 would add requirements to provide documents related to the child's care, placement, services, and permanency plan, Foster Care Review Office reports, all case numbers and court records, available photographs, and a written explanation of the reason the child is leaving foster care.

LB945 would also authorize a child or a child's guardian ad litem to request access to any other documents, information, or materials pertaining to the child's case.
