Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB1013 creates the Family Engagement Grant Program to provide grants for high-need schools in order to improve the level of family engagement at those schools. The program will be administered by the Nebraska Department of Education (NDE).

Grants can be used for the following:

- to provide tutoring to parents who wish to serve as school volunteers
- to provide communications to parents who wish to serve as school volunteers
- to provide training on ways to enhance the level of family engagement within the school
- to provide materials for parents & students to work on together at home
- for any other purpose designed to improve the level of family engagement at the school. Those purposes must be approved by NDE

School districts that receive a grant will submit a report to NDE that includes a description of how the grant funds were used & any measurable outcomes for families & students impacted by the grant. The report will be submitted by the end of the school year in which the grant was received.

## **EXPENDITURES:**

There is intent for \$1,000,000 to be appropriated annually to the Family Engagement Grant Program.

NDE estimates the need to add an additional FTE to coordinate, monitor, & administer the Family Engagement Grant Program. For FY2024-25, the FTE will a salary/benefits expense of \$102,150; & operating expenses of \$21,592. For FY2025-26, the FTE will a salary/benefits expense of \$105,310; & operating expenses of \$17,527.

Aid expenses total \$870,750 in FY2024-25 and \$869,252 in FY2025-26.
