LB1066 would authorize a school board to adopt a policy allowing a student in kindergarten through twelfth grade to attend released time to participate in an elective course in religious instruction conducted off school district property by a sponsoring entity.

While attending released time, a student will not be considered absent from school. Released time for a student in middle school or high school will only be for one class period of up to one hour per semester. No student can be released from a core curriculum course to attend released time.

The Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) would have minimal costs to develop the standards for class attendance & criteria for release time to qualify for elective courses, those costs can be absorbed by their current appropriation.
