LB 1069 changes provisions related to the State Fire Marshal.

As amended, LB 1069 changes provisions related to inspections and investigations under the Nebraska Natural Gas Pipeline Safety Act of 1969.

Section 9 of the original bill contains outright repeal of section 81-502.02. By repealing this section of statute, the State Fire Marshal will reduce the number of boilers being inspected by approximately 600 per year. Similarly, approximately 200 fewer install inspections will be conducted per year. Fewer inspections will result in a revenue decrease.

The Fire Marshal estimates no fiscal impact. This estimate appears to be reasonable.
