AM 2369 aims to adjust the population thresholds within section 43-2,119. Specifically, it would set the upper population limit for counties eligible for two judges at 300,000 inhabitants, while establishing a lower population threshold of 500,000 inhabitants for counties that qualify for six judges. Furthermore, counties that have a population ranging between 300,000 and 500,000 inhabitants would be entitled to four judges.

There is no fiscal impact to the state.
