Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1213 provides definitions and requires employers to grant each employee a minimum of twenty hours (20) of paid school activities leave in each calendar year.

The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) estimates a maximum cost to provide such paid leave for state employees to be \$9,791,025. This estimate is based on 17,725 employees and the average salary of state employees.

It is unlikely that every state employee would utilize the full 20 hours of paid leave each year, therefore the fiscal impact of LB 1213 is unlikely to reach the maximum cost estimate. DAS has also provided a fund source breakdown for these costs.

It should be noted that this estimate is not the cost to DAS. Rather, this is a statewide estimate. Costs would be incurred for each agency as benefits are utilized.

**Explanation of Estimate:** 

LB 1213 as introduced would require the State to provide employees a minimum of 20 hours of paid leave per calendar year for school-related activities.

LB 1213 would have a fiscal impact; however, it is difficult to determine the number of employees that would utilize such leave. To estimate such fiscal impact, using data from the most recently published State Personnel Almanac (2023), the number of State employees is 17,725 and the average salary is \$57,096 or \$27.45/hour (\$57,096 / 2080 hours = \$27.45 per hour). Based on this data, the fiscal impact could be as high as \$549.00 per calendar year (\$27.45 X 20 hours = \$549.00 per year) per employee, which for 17,725 employees, is \$9,731,025.00 (\$549 X 17,725 employees = \$9,731,025.00). Given that these numbers are from December of 2022, the average salary is anticipated to be higher than estimated here.

The table below summarizes the estimated impact by fund type of the estimated increased enterprise-wide due to an increase in paid leave. The allocation by fund type is based on an average of salaries (PSL) expenditures over a four-year period (2020-2023).
