Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1262 creates the Commission on Indian Affairs Act (Act). The Act would require the Commission on Indian Affairs (Commission) to contract with a consultant to conduct a study to determine any barriers to voting and equal representation for Indian tribes in Nebraska as is described in the bill.

As the bill is written, the Act would require the study to be conducted on an ongoing basis. The findings of such a study and recommended policy changes would be submitted to both the State-Tribal Relations Committee and the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee of the Legislature in December of 2025. An updated report would be required to be submitted to the two Legislative Committees in December of 2027 and in December of each even-numbered year thereafter.

The Commission would be required to identify an entity that possesses the expertise to conduct a study as defined in the bill. Due to the timing of the report, the funding would need to be appropriated in FY2024-25. Based on initial information that was provided to the Commission, it is anticipated that the cost would be \$180,000 for the initial study The cost for the updated studies in the future years is unknown and would create an ongoing need for additional appropriation.

Since LB 1262 includes an emergency clause, one can assume the work will begin in fiscal year 2024-25 with a portion of the expenditures occurring in the same year.

Technical Note: This will be an ongoing study with a subsequent report due in December 2027 and updated reports submitted in December of each even-numbered year thereafter.
