Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB1265 aims to prioritize the allocation of the initial \$1.5 million in grants to statewide legal service providers. These providers specialize in offering direct, free civil legal services to housing matters. Following the distribution of these funds, any remaining grant money will be allocated to service providers that offer other types of free civil legal services.

LB1265 does not have a fiscal impact on Nebraska Commission on Public Advocacy, but notes that the Legal Aid and Services Fund, is entirely supported by filing fees. This fund's revenue was \$1,635,213 in 2022 and increased to \$1,721,736 in 2023.

Currently, there are three statewide agencies that receive funding for providing free legal services related to housing. Under the new allocation strategy of LB1265, these agencies are set to receive the first \$1.5 million of the grant. Should this occur, other agencies currently funded may not receive their allocation until November, contingent on the fund's revenue inflow. This delay could potentially affect the availability of funding for agencies that provide free civil legal services in areas such as immigration and domestic violence assistance.
