NU would distribute the full amount to the University of Nebraska College of Law for the tenant assistance project administered by the Housing Justice Clinic. If passed, the \$1,000,000 appropriated through LB 1266 would be used toward expenses necessary to operate the program, as well as for contracted services provided by the Nebraska State Bar Association Volunteer Lawyers Project. According to NU, the program director and housing resource navigator positions currently exist and are are funded by various grants and other sources through May 2024.
