Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill allows recognition of commitment orders, emergency protective custody (EPC), on the basis of mental health and/or sex offences for any person domiciled within Indian country. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) offers estimated rates for one month of EPC services for one individual, \$45,987 for a community-based hospital and \$29,460 at the Lincoln Regional Center.

As amended, the bill specifies that the tribe shall make arrangements for payment of the cost of treatment services, and therefore there would be no additional cost to the state. DHHS notes that if tribal orders are required to be reported in the Electronic Commitment Reporting Application (ECRA) then the system would need to be updated. System updates to ECRA are anticipated to be less than \$5,000 and can be absorbed by the agency.

Explanation of Estimate:

LB1288 provides for the recognition of tribal commitment orders due to mental health and/or dangerous sex offenses and for the transportation of persons civilly committed under tribal law.

This bill designates any person domiciled within Indian country to be a covered subject concerning mental health involuntary commitment or placement under emergency protective custody. In such a case, where the subject is domiciled within Indian country in Nebraska and is committed for treatment under tribal law, the tribe shall make arrangements for payment of the cost of such treatment services per AM2695.

The cost of a single person committed for 30 days (assuming fiscal year 2024-2025 rates are paid for 7 days of acute care and 23 days of subacute care):

- Community-based hospital
 - \$45,987
- Lincoln Regional Center (LRC)
 - \$29,460
 - Plus, any amount needed to compensate jails due to the prevention of admission of other persons in need of facility services.

The Department of Health and Human Services does not have an estimate for the number of individuals this could affect because emergency protective custody is not currently an option within tribes. Also, there is not an estimate on how long a tribal person would be expected to remain at any hospital since dismissal requires external approval.

If Tribal orders are required to be included in the reporting database, the Electronic Commitment Reporting Application (ECRA) will need to be updated. Changes to the ECRA database to allow for Tribal Court courts/personnel to enter data is estimated at less than \$5,000. The department will absorb these costs.
