Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 1329, as written, transfers responsibility for the Nebraska Career Scholarships awarded to community college students and to private nonprofit college students from the Department of Economic Development (DED) to the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education (CCPE). The Commission's existing infrastructure for administering the Nebraska Opportunity Grant will be used to award, distribute, and report on Nebraska Career Scholarships. The Commission reports that existing appropriations are expected to be sufficient to administer this program.

Language in the bill requires the Commission to allocate to Nebraska's community colleges and private nonprofit colleges the amount appropriated. For FY2024-25, \$8,000,000 is appropriated, with \$4,000,000 allocated to the community colleges and \$4,000,000 allocated to Nebraska's private nonprofit institutions.

The University of Nebraska reports that, if passed, LB 1329 would have minimal impact to its system. The Nebraska State College System reports no fiscal impact.

The DED response projects a modest favorable impact to the DED in terms of workload.

There would be no change in the total dollar amount of State Aid appropriation, but an appropriations bill may be needed to decrease General Fund aid to the DED by \$8,000,000 while increasing general fund aid to the CCPE by the same amount.
