Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB1337 adopts the School Construction Financing Act to streamline the process of school construction projects & provide state support to school construction projects while maintaining & protecting local control for school districts.

A school district is eligible to apply for matching funds from the State of Nebraska of up to fifty percent of the cost of a school construction project for use on that project if the school district:

- Has had extraordinary growth within the five years prior to applying for matching funds
- · Has had recent destruction or damage to educational facilities by fire or natural disaster
- Is required to replace facilities due to the facilities being certified by the appropriate inspection individual to be hazardous to health or safety or to be in a violation of any health or safety standards

The Commissioner of Education will approve or deny applications for matching funds pursuant to the School Construction Financing Act & will include the cost for any approved application as part of the commissioner's operating budget request submitted to the Legislature & the Governor.

## **EXPENDITURES:**

The Nebraska Department of Education (NDE) estimates an expense of \$20,000 to contract with a programmer to build the initial data collection required to obtain the necessary information that will be included in the applications. NDE will include the cost for any approved application as part of their operating budget request submitted to the Legislature & the Governor.

There is no indication of the limitations of the amount that can or will be distributed by NDE, the fiscal impact cannot be determined at this time.
