This bill modifies the responsibilities of the Foster Care Reimbursement Rate Committee within the Nebraska Children's Commission, a program within the Foster Care Review Office. It renames the committee the Child Welfare and Foster Care Reimbursement Rate Committee and adds two newly required members. The additional responsibilities would require the addition of 1 FTE Administrative Technician in the amount of \$86,048 in FY25 and \$71,524 in FY26.
