LB140 provides for the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to issue Czech heritage plates. These plates will be available as both alphanumeric and personalized, with fees charged accordingly at both the initial application and renewal times. If ever the cost of manufacturing the plates exceeds the amount charged in fees, the revenue will first be credited to the Highway Trust Fund in the amount equal to the production cost overage. The remainder of the revenue, would then be distributed as normal to the DMV Cash Fund. Additionally, during the 2023 plate issuance cycle (the 6 -year cycle started on January 1, 2023), if there is ever less than 500 Czech plates registered in any two consecutive years, the DMV shall cease to issue Czech plates at the next plate issuance cycle.

The operative date of this bill is January 1, 2024.

## Expenditures:

The DMV estimates there would be approximately 500 sets (or 1,000 plates) produced in the first year of issuance, at a cost of $\$ 4,100$ for FY2024-25 (1,000 x \$4.10). As the plates would likely grow in visibility and popularity, the second year expenses are estimated to be doubled, with an expense of $\$ 8,200$ for FY2025-26 ( $2,000 \times \$ 4.10$ ).

## Revenue:

The DMV estimates the plate registrations would be $75 \%$ alphanumeric and $25 \%$ personalized message plates. This would equate to $\$ 6,875$ revenue for FY2024-25 and \$13,750 for FY2025-26.

## Explanation of Estimate:

LB 140 provides for Czech Heritage license plates. Each application for initial and renewal issuance of alphanumeric plates shall be accompanied with a five-dollar fee which is to be credited to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. In addition, a fee of forty dollars will be collected for initial issuance or renewal of personalized plates which is to be credited to Department of Motor Vehicle Cash Fund.

DMV is to design the plates to limit the manufacturing cost of each plate to an amount less than or equal to the amount charged for licensing plates per section 60-3,102. If the cost of manufacturing these plates exceeds the amount charged pursuant to section 60-3,102, the revenue from the additional plate fee will be credited first to the Highway Trust Fund to cover the cost of manufacturing with the remainder credited to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.

No fiscal impact is anticipated to the Department.
