LB 16. as amended, changes provisions related to the make-up of the State Electrical Board and issuance of licenses.

\$8.900

Sections 5-8 amend the Occupational Board Reform Act. Potentially disqualifying convictions are addressed in section 5 and "United States Military is defined in section 6. LB 16 also includes occupation groups that are excluded from the Act.

Section 9 allows individuals with criminal convictions to submit an application for licensure, government certification, or state recognition of the individual's personal qualifications to the appropriate occupational board.

The State Electrical Division estimates no fiscal impact.

The Department of Labor estimates no fiscal impact.

There is no basis to disagree with these estimates.

AM2229 is the Interior Design Voluntary Registration Act. To be registered, interior designers shall apply to the State Treasurer, pay an application fee of not more than \$50, and satisfy the requirements for placement on the registry. The State Treasurer shall list each interior designer registration which shall contain the individual's full name and any other information as the Treasurer may require by rules and regulations. Registered interior designers shall obtain a seal from the State Treasurer.

Beginning January 1, 2025, it shall be unlawful for any person to use the title registered interior designer or similar description to convey the impression that such person is a registered interior designer unless the person in registered under the Act.

The State Treasurer estimates a cost of \$8,900 in FY25 to establish the registry, produce and distribute seals to registrants. Ongoing costs are estimated to be \$1,000 per year thereafter. Revenue is estimated to be \$6,500 in FY25 and \$1,000 per year thereafter.

These estimates appear to be reasonable.

Also, the Treasurer will need to create a seal and distribute those to registrants. The Treasurer may charge a fee up to \$50, which is directed to the Treasurer Administrative fund – and then credited to the UP Cash Fund quarterly. According to the NCIDQ website, there are currently 234 registered interior designers in the State of Nebraska, about 130 of which show an active registration. We estimate that 130 people would voluntarily register under the Interior Design Voluntary Registration Act. The cost estimate to produce a seal for each registered interior designer is \$30 and an estimate to mail that seal to each registered interior designer is \$20. We anticipate most, or all, of the registrations will

According to the NCIDQ website, there are currently 234 registered interior designers in the State of Nebraska, about 130 of which show an active registration. We estimate that 130 people would voluntarily register under the Interior Design Voluntary Registration Act. The cost estimate to produce a seal for each registered interior designer is \$30 and at estimate to mail that seal to each registered interior designer is \$20. We anticipate most, or all, of the registrations will occur shortly after the Act becomes operative. Some of the labor that would be involved with this act would be absorbed in the Treasurer's current operating budget, however we would look to hire temporary labor to coordinate with each registrant on ordering the seals and mailing the seals. This work would hopefully take place over a short period of time, limiting the amount of temporary labor to a two-week period in FY 2024-25. The estimates in this include this temporary labor cost. This work would end after all initial registrants have received their seals. However, there could be future costs as new interior designers register, and at the expiration of the registration. It isn't known how many new registrations will be made in following fiscal years. For this fiscal note, we are estimating receiving 20 registrations in FY 2025-26. Again, the costs to implement this bill are difficult to project.
