## Explanation of Estimate:

LB280 creates the Interstate Massage Compact (IMpact). The Council of State Governments is partnering with the Department of Defense and the Federation of State Massage Therapy Boards to support the mobility of licensed massage therapists through the development of a new interstate compact. This additional licensing pathway will create reciprocity among participant states.

Neb. Rev. Stat. 38-131 will need to be revised to include massage therapists in the authorizing statute for national fingerprint-based criminal history checks.

The current IT Business Systems Analyst II in the Department of Health and Human Services Occupational Licensure Unit will need to update the License Information System (LIS) to be able to identify "single-state" versus "multi-state" licenses and to transfer data to the Commission Data Bank. This new work will require 20 hours for the IT Business Systems Analyst II to complete.

Once the compact becomes operational, application forms will need to be revised to include compact information. This new work will require 8 hours for the Health Licensing Coordinator to complete.

Website updates will be needed to include information about the compact and the updated application forms. This new work will require 4 hours for the Administrative Specialist to complete.
