### Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill changes provisions relating to child abuse and neglect under the Child Protection and Safety Act and the Nebraska Juvenile Code. The Department of Health and Human Services and the State Patrol indicate no fiscal impact to their agencies. The Supreme Court indicates the bill would require judicial education on the changes. Judicial workload may change as judges may spend more time evaluating the criteria for determining child abuse and neglect. The fiscal impact is indeterminable though the agency indicates no additional resources would be required. Nebraska Department of Corrections indicates this bill could reduce the number of people in prison however the extent of such an impact is unknown. There is no basis to disagree with the analysis of the agencies.

LB42 changes provisions relating to child abuse and neglect under the Child Protection and Family Safety Act and the Nebraska Juvenile Code. The bill could reduce the number of persons in prison. The specific amount of impact is indeterminable.

As of December 2022, the average daily prison population (ADP) was 147% of design capacity. The FY22 per diem cost was \$28.38 for each inmate, or \$10,358.63 per year.
