### Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 53, creates a new state holiday. Several agencies report a fiscal impact based on their respective number of employees who would be required to work on a holiday, with the dollar amount being a calculation of the difference between their normal rate and the holiday pay rate.

Some agencies reported that they would be able to make internal adjustments to absorb added costs. Below is a preliminary estimate of the total reported incremental costs to agencies who do not make this claim.

These projections are based on current rates of pay. Because many of these agencies will also be impacted by implementation of recently-negotiated labor contracts (e.g. Nebraska State Patrol @ 22.1% increase), this fiscal note could be amended after the contracts are formally executed and made available for review.

In addition, the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) explains that upon the passage of LB 53, its Employee Relations department would negotiate agreements with all four labor unions (NAPE/AFSCME, FOP 88, SLEBC and SCATA) to make the necessary adjustments to the Labor Contracts, websites, policy, and marketing material, but that these activities could be accomplished with existing resources.

**Explanation of Estimate:** 

LB53 creates a new holiday in Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 25-2221 and 62-301 entitled Birthday of El-Hajj Malik El-Shabazz, Malcolm X, for May 19.

If passed as introduced, this bill would cause state teammates to receive the new state holiday as Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84-1001, which outlines state holidays, indicates that paid holidays include all days enumerated in Neb. Rev. Stat. § 25-2221.

The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) - Employee Relations would negotiate agreements with all four labor unions, NAPE/AFSCME, FOP 88, SLEBC and SCATA, to make the necessary adjustments to the Labor Contracts, websites, policy, and marketing material, all of which can be done with existing staff.

The state would incur additional costs above a normal operating day as a result of state teammates working at a holiday pay rate as outlined in the applicable labor contract. Based on historical averages this cost would run between \$460,600 and \$575,750 including FICA and retirement. The state would also lose the productivity of teammates who are not working on that day, which cannot be accurately quantified.

It is difficult to determine the exact impact by fund type as some agencies/programs are impacted more by additional holiday and benefit costs because of their need for 24/7 coverage. Future costs will also increase with salary increases.

The table below summarizes the estimated impact by fund type of the estimated range in increased enterprise-wide salary expenditures. The allocation by fund type below is based on an average of salaries (PSL) expenditures over a four-year time period (2019-2022).

LB 53 creates El-Hajj Malik El-Shabazz, Malcolm X Day and establishes a holiday on May 19th of each year.

Based on comparison of recent pay periods that include a paid holiday to those that do not include a paid holiday, the NDCS estimates the additional cost for one observed holiday to be approximately \$700,090. This amount includes \$607,981 PSL and \$92,109 benefits.

The creation and establishment of "Malcolm X Day" on May 19 of each calendar year as a state holiday would increase Holiday premium pay for both facility and non-facility Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) workers. In the first half of State Fiscal Year 2023, the average Holiday premium pay was **\$353,650**. The lowest paid holiday was July 4th at \$297,099 and the highest paid was Dec 25 at \$576,582.

**Explanation of Estimate:** 

No Net Fiscal Impact.

The addition of a State Holiday in May affects the increased staffing costs at Park locations due to being during preparation of the busy summer camping season.

Using 50% of the 5-year average OT figures from Independence Day, (as this will not be an additional Federal Day), an increase of 450 staffing hours (OT and Compensatory) would be expected. At the average 2022 cost per hour of Overtime pay (\$26.88), this would be an additional \$12,096.00 in staffing costs. (This is wages only, and does not include any benefits).

The Nebraska Game and Parks Commission would make internal adjustments to compensate for the additional wages needed.

**Explanation of Estimate:** 

LB 53 provides for the addition of a new holiday, EI-Hajj Malik EI-Shabazz, Malcolm X Day. A fiscal impact has been reflected, as it would require the Agency to pay for the additional costs that would be incurred from employees working on this additional holiday. The amounts reflected in this fiscal note are the difference between paying employees at their regular rate of pay as compared to 1.5x their regular rate of pay, and in the case of overtime, at 2.0x their regular rate of pay. This includes an estimate based on historical hours worked on similar holidays for Troopers, Sergeant, Investigative Officers, investigative Sergeants, and Communications Specialists (dispatchers).

Note that the estimated amounts provided do not include the additional large salary increases (22.1%) that are anticipated with the formalization of the SLEBC labor contract that will be effective 7/1/23. In order to accurately reflect these costs, this fiscal note should be amended when the contract is formally executed.
