Explanation of Estimate:

LB573 appropriates \$10 million from the General Fund in fiscal year 2023-2024 and another \$10 million from the General Fund in fiscal year 2024-2025 to DED for a time-limited grant program that awards grants to cities of the first class within the first Congressional district who wish to revitalize real property that was previously owned by a university or college for the purposes of economic development. Grants are to be awarded to non-profits who provide a 1-to-1 match to grant funds.

Under LB573, the Department will expect to need the services of 1.0 Econ Dev Business Consultant II to administer and monitor the program and 0.25 Accountant III to handle payments. Operating costs include approximately \$22,700 annually for grant management software and licenses and \$2,000 for additional leased office space. DED expects that the grants will be paid out approximately 30%, 60%, and 10% in FY2023-24 through FY2025-26, respectively.
