LB624 amends 81-3710 to place the administration of the Tourism Commission within the Department of Economic Development. strikes requirements for membership of the commission, and establishes a director of the Commission who serves at the pleasure of the Director of Economic Development.

FY23-24 appropriation to the Tourism Commission is \$7,525, 272 in Cash Funds, and FY24-25 appropriation is \$7,583,744. The impact of this bill will be a reduction in appropriations to the Tourism Commission with a corresponding increase in the Department of Economic Development.

Tourism Commission's fiscal note is based upon the requested appropriations from its budget request for FY23-24 and FY24-25.

As written, there will be a net zero fiscal impact.
