- 2) DHHS costs to revoke licenses resulting from violation of the Nebraska Heartbeat Act include additional work from DHHS Program Manager(s), DHHS Professional Boards, and Professional and Occupational Licensing Investigators. These costs would be absorbed within the existing investigations process unless there is an extremely high number of complaints alleged.
