Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB828 amends the Nebraska Apiary Act in the following ways:

- Allows for the department to provide education on beekeeping practices;
- Amends definitions under the act;

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- Adds definition for pollinator and specialty crop under the act;
- Adds a misdemeanor for failing to register an apiary under the act;
- Creates the Pollinator Task Force and describes the membership and duties as such:
  - Director of Agriculture or their designee;
  - Director of Natural Resources or their designee;
  - Director of Environment and Energy of their designee;
  - Director of Game and Parks or their designee;
  - o The Director-State Engineer of the Department of Transportation or their designee;
    - The following members to be appointed by the Director of Agriculture and approved by the Legislature:
      - A representative of a natural resources district;
      - A representative of a recreation and park association;
      - A representative of a conservation organization;
      - An individual who commercially grows at least one specialty crop;
      - An individual who commercial grows crops that are dependent upon pollinators;
      - One professional educator in the field of pesticide use or environmental effects of pesticides;
      - One pesticide dealer;
      - One commercial applicator;
      - One beekeeper;
      - A member of the general public not described above.
    - Terms are described as, "shall serve until next July 1" and members may serve multiple terms;
  - Vacancies are to be filled by the Director of Agriculture with replacement members to serve the remainder of the term;
    - Creates a requirement to meet twice annually;
    - o Creates a reimbursement for members expenses;
      - Creates intent to invite participation at Pollinator Task Force Meetings from the following:
        - A representative from an Indian Tribe of Nebraska;
        - A representative from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln Department of Entomology;
        - A representative younger than nineteen who participates in an organization that encourages students to engage in agriculture; and
          - Any subject matter expert.
    - The bill sets the purpose of the Pollinator Task Force and requires the development of a pollinator plan by the task force and lists the topics to be included;
    - o Requires the plan to be submitted to the Legislature by November 1, 2026 and each November 1 thereafter;
    - Allows for the Task Force to employ individuals for apiary inspections and apiary or pollinator research;
- Creates the Nebraska Apiary Registry with an effective date of January 1, 2025, creates a timeline for apiary registration, lists the contents of the registry;
  - Creates the following fee schedule for registration under the fund with remittance of such fees to the State Apiary Cash Fund:
    - For veterans and persons 65 years or old, \$10, all others \$15. Each apiary location is a \$1 fee;
    - Makes registration information confidential with listed exceptions provided to University of Nebraska faculty and departments;

- Requires the Department of Agriculture to notify all persons with registered apiaries of any outbreaks within a fivemile radius of said apiary;
- o Allows for the Department of Agriculture to promulgate rules and regulations under the act;
- Excepts registered apiary owners from liability related to injury or stings within a two-mile radius of such apiary with exceptions for negligence or intent; and
- Allows for the Department of Agriculture to provide proof of registration to a party in a suit for damages.

No basis to dispute the estimates provided by the Nebraska Department of Agriculture.

#### **Explanation of Estimate:**

The department will require an additional FTE for an Agriculture Program Specialist to assist the Pollinator Task Force by conducting apiary inspections and research. This position will also establish and administer the Nebraska Apiary Registry. An additional operating expense in FY2024-25 is the development of a fee collection system and software required for the registry. Travel expenses include travel for inspections and task force member reimbursement to attend meetings.

BeeCheck, a voluntary apiary registry by FieldWatch for those who sell a portion of their crop or have at least 5 hives, is currently available in Nebraska. There are approx. 275 beekeepers and 750 locations registered with BeeCheck. The Department utilized this data to determine expected revenue to the State Apiary Cash Fund. There are beekeepers and locations not realized in the BeeCheck registry; however this provides the closest estimate. The department will require General Funds to cover the shortfall to fund the program.

Current revenue into the State Apiary Cash Fund is for certificates issued at a beekeepers request as provided for in 81-2,273. Since July 1, 2018, the fund has received a total of \$600 in fees for issuing four certificates. The cash balance of the fund was \$165 as of December 31, 2023.

The Department of Agriculture will create and maintain the new Nebraska Apiary Registry.

There is no fiscal impact to Game and Parks.

LB828 amends the Nebraska Apiary Act by defining and redefining terms. The proposed bill creates the Pollinator Task Force and requires the Director-State Engineer of the Department of Transportation or designee to be included as a member of the task force. Task members will serve without compensation but shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for expenses pursuant to sections 81-1174 to 81-1177.

Participation cost in the Pollinator Task Force can be accomplished withing existing appropriation.
