This bill expands provisions of Safe Haven laws in Nebraska by creating the Newborn Safe Haven Act. The bill states legislative intent to appropriate \$65,000 in FY25 and \$10,000 in FY26 and beyond to maintain to program including updating webpages, distribution of literature, and development of educational, promotional, and informational materials for multiple formats. There is no administrative cost beyond the intended appropriation.

The Department of Health and Human Services notes that increased surrenders may lead to increased child welfare costs which are indeterminable.
