Section 32-559 is amended to include election parameters and procedures regarding elections for the purpose of approving the issuance of bonds, a property tax levy, or exceeding a property tax levy limitation by a school district.

The Department of Education anticipates no fiscal impact but advises that school districts will realize an impact. NDE is unable to determine the extent of any costs.

The Secretary of State estimates no fiscal impact.
