LB 926 amends the Museum Property Act by adding methods a public notification may be given, specifically a post on the museum's website or a physical notification within a public area of the museum for 3 consecutive weeks. This occurs after the museum is unable to communicate with the owner of the loaned property.

The bill also decreases the amount of time claimants have to respond to a notice the museum is asserting title to the property from three years to one year before the museum assumes ownership.

The bill it increases the amount of time the museum must retain written records of assumed property from 3 years to 25 years.
