Explanation of Estimate:

While the mechanics of the allowing for calls will not have a fiscal impact, the functionality of this could affect the number of calls routed to 988 and therefore the cost of operating 988 may increase due to the need for more staff. The FY24 contract is based on 46,994 inbound and outbound calls as well as 19,227 text and chat sessions (total of 66,221). This contract is set to increase to 94,924 calls, chats, and texts in FY25. If call volumes increase past this, additional staff may be needed for Boys Town to maintain required call response times. Increased call volumes may increase the cost to the Department of Health and Human Services' vendors, which may in turn increase contract costs to the Department.
