- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to define terms; and to create the
- 2 Family Engagement Grant Program.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) For purposes of this section:
- 2 (a) Department means the State Department of Education;
- 3 (b) High-need school means a school with high absenteeism and low
- 4 <u>academic achievement</u>, as determined by the department;
- 5 (c) School has the same meaning as in section 79-101; and
- 6 (d) School district has the same meaning as in section 79-101.
- 7 (2) The Family Engagement Grant Program is created. The purpose of
- 8 the program is to provide grants for high-need schools in order to
- 9 <u>improve the level of family engagement at such schools. The program shall</u>
- 10 be administered by the department.
- 11 (3) A school district may apply for a grant under this section to be
- 12 <u>used at one or more schools within such school district. The application</u>
- 13 shall be submitted to the department in a form and manner prescribed by
- 14 the department.
- 15 (4) The department shall develop eligibility criteria for grants
- 16 <u>under this section. At a minimum, the eligibility criteria shall require</u>
- 17 <u>the school district to show that it contains one or more high-need</u>
- 18 schools within such school district.
- 19 <u>(5) A grant awarded under the Family Engagement Grant Program may be</u>
- 20 <u>used:</u>
- 21 (a) To provide tutoring to parents who wish to serve as school
- 22 volunteers;
- 23 (b) To provide communications to parents who wish to serve as school
- 24 <u>volunteers;</u>
- 25 (c) To provide training on ways to enhance the level of family
- 26 <u>engagement within the school;</u>
- 27 <u>(d) To provide materials for parents and students to work on</u>
- 28 together at home; or
- 29 <u>(e) For any other purpose designed to improve the level of family</u>
- 30 engagement at the school. Any such purpose must be approved by the
- 31 <u>department</u>.

- 1 (6) Each school district that receives a grant under this section
- 2 shall submit a report to the department that includes a description of
- 3 how the grant funds were used and any measurable outcomes for families
- 4 and students impacted by such grant. The report shall be submitted by the
- 5 end of the school year in which the grant was received.
- 6 (7) The department may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to
- 7 <u>carry out this section.</u>
- 8 (8) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate one million
- 9 dollars to the department each fiscal year to carry out the Family
- 10 <u>Engagement Grant Program.</u>
