- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to health and human services; to state intent
- 2 regarding an increase in rates for child welfare aid; and to declare
- 3 an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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families in Nebraska.

- 1 It is the intent of the Legislature that the Department 2 of Health and Human Services and the Supreme Court be appropriated funds 3 equivalent to implement a five-percent increase for fiscal year 2023-24 4 to reimbursement rates for all child welfare service providers under 5 Agency 25, Department of Health and Human Services, Program 354, Child Welfare Aid, and Agency 5, Supreme Court, Program 437, Juvenile Justice. 6 This increase is intended to be in addition to any other increase 7 8 provided by law. The child welfare and juvenile justice service providers receiving the increase, for those services currently used by Agency 25 9 10 and Agency 5, include providers of Group Home Services, Out-of-Home Care Services, Out-of-Home Maintenance, Agency-Supported Foster Care, 11 Emergency Shelter Center Care, Agency-Supported Respite Care, Drug 12 Testing, In-Home Family Support, Out-of-Home Family Support, Supervised 13 Visitation, In-Home Safety, Family Finding, Options Education, Kinship 14 Navigation, Home Studies, Travel Time and Distance, Intensive Family 15 16 Preservation, Intensive Family Reunification Service, and any other 17 service presently contracted for by the department with one or more private providers that is intended to meet the needs of children and 18
- Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
