- 15 <u>shall be made on a one-to-one match for local funds committed to</u>
- 16 providing for interoperability. An applicant receiving a grant under this
- 17 section shall not be awarded more than \$3,500,000.
- 18 There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24
- 19 \$5,000,000 Revolving Funds, which shall be used for the following
- 20 purposes:
- 21 (1) Establishing interoperable communications between state agencies
- 22 and volunteer departments as defined in section 35-901, by providing
- 23 portable and mobile radios, programming, and installation of all radios
- 24 and equipment; and
- 25 (2) Training for interoperability with the Statewide Radio System to
- 26 connect volunteer departments and agencies to the Statewide Radio System
- 27 through a grant program. Eligibility for such program shall be based on
- 28 the number and type of radios required for each volunteer department
- 29 based upon such department's needs and size. The office of the Chief
- 30 Information Officer shall not charge any subscription, programming, or
- 31 training fee for any volunteer department connected to the Statewide
