- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to criminal justice; to create the National
- 2 Career Readiness Certificate Pilot Program within the Department of
- 3 Correctional Services; to provide duties for the department; and to
- 4 state intent regarding appropriations.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The National Career Readiness Certificate Pilot
- 2 Program is created. The program shall be administered by the Department
- 3 of Correctional Services. The department shall collaborate with
- 4 enterprises offering justice-involved individuals the chance to acquire
- 5 the National Career Readiness Certificate, a broadly recognized
- 6 <u>credential substantiating key skills across various industries and roles.</u>
- 7 (2) The department shall evaluate the success of the program for
- 8 <u>each fiscal year and electronically submit a report of such evaluation to</u>
- 9 the Clerk of the Legislature on or before June 30, 2025, and June 30,
- 10 2026.
- 11 (3) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate five hundred
- 12 <u>thousand dollars from the General Fund for each of fiscal years 2024-25</u>
- 13 and 2025-26 to the department for expenditure and distribution to aid in
- 14 <u>carrying out the pilot program.</u>
