- There is included in the appropriation to this program for FY2023-24 12 \$75,000 Cash Funds and for FY2024-25 \$75,000 Cash Funds from the Nebraska 13 Health Care Cash Fund for the purpose of ongoing health-related research 14 and public policy development by the Health and Human Services Committee 15 16 of the Legislature. Such funds may be used for, but shall not be limited to, hiring temporary legal research assistance, consulting and research 17 contracts, reimbursement for necessary and appropriate expenses incurred 18 in connection with such research and policy development, and actual and 19 necessary travel reimbursement for task forces and committees established 20 to conduct health policy work. 21
- The unexpended General Fund appropriation balance existing on June 30, 2023, is hereby reappropriated.
- Sec. 2. Original Laws 2023, LB814, section 13, is repealed.
- Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
