- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to assessment of property; to amend sections
- 2 77-1344 and 77-1347, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023; to change
- 3 provisions relating to the special valuation of agricultural or
- 4 horticultural land; to provide for retroactive applicability; to
- 5 repeal the original sections; and to declare an emergency.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 77-1344, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 77-1344 (1) Agricultural or horticultural land which has an actual
- 4 value as defined in section 77-112 reflecting purposes or uses other than
- 5 agricultural or horticultural purposes or uses shall be assessed as
- 6 provided in subsection (3) of section 77-201 if the land meets the
- 7 qualifications of this subsection and an application for such special
- 8 valuation is filed and approved pursuant to section 77-1345. In order for
- 9 the land to qualify for special valuation, the land shall must be
- 10 agricultural or horticultural land and (a) the land shall must consist of
- 11 five <u>contiguous</u> acres or more <u>or (b) if the land consists of less than</u>
- 12 <u>five contiguous acres, the owner or lessee of the land shall provide an</u>
- 13 <u>Internal Revenue Service Schedule F or other suitable tax document</u>
- 14 reporting a profit or loss from farming for two out of the last three
- 15 years for such land.
- 16 (2) The eligibility of land for the special valuation provisions of
- 17 this section shall be determined each year as of January 1. If the land
- 18 so qualified becomes disqualified on or before December 31 of that year,
- 19 it shall continue to receive the special valuation until January 1 of the
- 20 year following.
- 21 (3) The special valuation placed on such land by the county assessor
- 22 under this section shall be subject to equalization by the county board
- 23 of equalization and the Tax Equalization and Review Commission.
- 24 (4) The changes made in this section by this legislative bill shall
- 25 apply retroactively to January 1, 2023.
- Sec. 2. Section 77-1347, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2023, is
- 27 amended to read:
- 28 77-1347 Upon approval of an application, the county assessor shall
- 29 value the land as provided in section 77-1344 until the land becomes
- 30 disqualified for such valuation by:
- 31 (1) Written notification by the applicant or his or her successor in

- 1 interest to the county assessor to remove such special valuation;
- 2 (2) Inclusion of the land within the corporate boundaries of any
- 3 sanitary and improvement district, city, or village, except that this
- 4 subdivision shall not apply on or after January 1, 2023;—or
- 5 (3) The land no longer qualifying as agricultural or horticultural
- 6 land; or -
- 7 (4) For land that consists of less than five contiguous acres, the
- 8 <u>owner or lessee of the land not providing an Internal Revenue Service</u>
- 9 Schedule F or other suitable tax document reporting a profit or loss from
- 10 <u>farming for two out of the last three years.</u>
- 11 Sec. 3. Original sections 77-1344 and 77-1347, Revised Statutes
- 12 Supplement, 2023, are repealed.
- 13 Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 14 passed and approved according to law.
