- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to treatment and corrections; to require an
- 2 annual report on active cases by the Department of Correctional
- 3 Services, Office of Probation Administration, and Division of Parole
- 4 Supervision.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) On or before November 1 of each year, the Department
- 2 of Correctional Services, Office of Probation Administration, and
- 3 <u>Division of Parole Supervision shall provide a report to the Judiciary</u>
- 4 Committee of the Legislature and the Clerk of the Legislature. The report
- 5 <u>shall include the following information on each active case under the</u>
- 6 <u>supervision of the department, office, or division:</u>
- 7 (a) The age, race, ethnicity, and gender of the individual;
- 8 (b) The county of prior residence, if known;
- 9 (c) Citizenship status;
- 10 (d) Offense of conviction, including the relevant statute; degree,
- 11 <u>if applicable; and felony or misdemeanor classification level; and</u>
- 12 <u>(e) The type and length of sentence imposed.</u>
- 13 (2) Individual identifying information, including, but not limited
- 14 to, names, dates of birth, and addresses shall be omitted from the
- 15 report. The report shall be submitted electronically and made in a
- 16 machine-readable format.
