The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

The Nebraska Information Technology Commission is currently comprised of the following members:

- One member representing elementary and secondary education;
- One member representing postsecondary education;
- The Governor or his or her designee;
- One member representing communities;
- Five members representing the general public who have experience in developing strategic plans and making high-level business decisions; and
- A member of the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee of the Legislature (ex officio, nonvoting).

LB1038 would provide that of the members representing the general public, the principal business or occupation of at least one such member shall be agriculture. This requirement would provide representation on the Nebraska Information Technology Commission to one of Nebraska's primary economic sectors: agriculture.
