The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB1056 would create the School Construction Assistance Task Force to study issues and develop recommendations relating to how best the State can assist school districts with construction. The task force would be composed of:

- A member of the Education Committee of the Legislature,
- A member of the Appropriations Committee of the Legislature,
- A member of the Revenue Committee of the Legislature,
- A representative of the Governor's office,
- A superintendent of a school district with 10,000 students or more,
- A superintendent of a school district with more than 1,000 students and fewer than 10,000 students,
- 2 superintendents of school districts with fewer than 1,000 students,
- A representative of the capital construction industry,
- A representative of the statewide chamber of commerce

The task force would file a report of recommendations to the Education, Appropriations, and Revenue committees of the Legislature by September 1st, 2025.
