The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB1057 reaffirms that whether a case is transferred or filed in juvenile court depends on the age of the youth at the time of the commission of the offense. The Nebraska Supreme Court has recently articulated a different measure of juvenile court jurisdiction that instead looks to the age of the youth at the time the charge is filed against them. See State v. Cardenas, 314 Neb. 544 (2023) and State v. Pauly, 311 Neb. 418 (2022). Legislative Bill 1057 would reaffirm that whether a case is transferred or filed in juvenile court depends on the age of the youth at the time of the commission of the offense.
