The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB 1130 would allow the holder of a second provisional mental health practitioner license who has not completed the required 3,000 hours of supervised experience in mental health practice the opportunity to appeal to the board for a third provisional mental health practitioner license for a term of five years. It would also grant the board the ability to grant a third provisional mental health practitioner license upon demonstration of hardship by the provisional licensee due to certain circumstances and allow the board to adopt additional requirements for granting an appeal.
