7 used for administration of the Nebraska Racetrack Gaming Act. Transfers  
8 may be made from the fund to the General Fund at the direction of the  
9 Legislature. Any money in the Racing and Gaming Commission's Racetrack  
10 Gaming Fund available for investment shall be invested by the state  
11 investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the

8 create high-quality jobs, increase business investment, and revitalize
