

AMENDMENTS TO LB304

Introduced by Spivey, 13.

1           1. On page 3, after line 19 insert the following new subdivision:

2           "(ii) The income of a qualified apprentice shall not be considered  
3 when determining eligibility for access to a federal child care subsidy  
4 if the total household income is less than two hundred fifty percent of  
5 the federal poverty level. A household qualifying for the program under  
6 this section shall be entitled to receive up to fifty percent of the  
7 subsidy to which the household would otherwise be entitled. For purposes  
8 of this subdivision, qualified apprentice means an individual who is: (A)  
9 Represented by an organization described in section 501(c)(5) of the  
10 Internal Revenue Code of 1986; and (B) employed by a redeveloper,  
11 contractor, or subcontractor participating in a registered apprenticeship  
12 program, as defined in 26 U.S.C. 3131(e)(3)(B), if the training facility  
13 of such program is located in Nebraska."; in line 20 strike "(ii)", show  
14 as stricken, and insert "(iii)"; and in line 29 strike "(iii)", show as  
15 stricken, and insert "(iv)".

16           2. On page 4, line 2, strike "(iv)", show as stricken, and insert  
17 "(v)" and strike "(2)(b)(ii) and (2)(b)(iii)", show as stricken, and  
18 insert "(2)(b)(iii) and (2)(b)(iv)".
