Introduced by Education.

1 1. Strike the original sections and insert the following new
2 sections:

3 **Section 1.** Section 79-2,136, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2025, is
4 amended to read:

5 79-2,136 (1) Each school board shall allow the part-time enrollment
6 of students, for all courses selected by the students, who are residents
7 of, or admitted to, the school district pursuant to subsection (1), (2),
8 or (11) of section 79-215 and who are also enrolled in a private,
9 denominational, or parochial school or in a school which elects pursuant
10 to section 79-1601 not to meet accreditation or approval requirements and
11 shall establish policies and procedures for such part-time enrollment.
12 Such policies and procedures may include provisions permitting the part-
13 time enrollment of such students who are not residents of, or admitted
14 to, such school districts to the extent permitted pursuant to section
15 79-215 and may require part-time students to follow school policies that
16 apply to other students at any time the part-time student is present on
17 school grounds or at a school-sponsored activity or athletic event. Part-
18 time enrollment shall not entitle a student to transportation or
19 transportation reimbursements pursuant to section 79-611.

20 (2) Each school board shall establish policies and procedures to
21 allow any student who is a resident of, or admitted to, the school
22 district pursuant to subsection (1), (2), or (11) of section 79-215 and
23 who is enrolled in a school which elects pursuant to section 79-1601 not
24 to meet accreditation or approval requirements to participate in any
25 extracurricular activities as defined in section 79-2,126, including, but
26 not limited to, interschool competitions, to the same extent and subject
27 to the same requirements, conditions, and procedures as a student

1 enrolled in a public school governed by such board, except that any
2 school which elects pursuant to section 79-1601 not to meet accreditation
3 or approval requirements shall set the standards for satisfactory
4 academic performance for a student from the school to participate in
5 extracurricular activities pursuant to this subsection and shall provide
6 assurances of compliance with such academic standards.

7 (3) School board policies and procedures adopted pursuant to
8 subsection (2) of this section;

9 (a) Shall ~~shall~~ require any student desiring to participate in
10 extracurricular activities regulated by an athletics or activities
11 association to which such school is a member pursuant to such subsection
12 to be enrolled in five credit hours offered by the school district in any
13 semester in order to participate in such extracurricular activities, but
14 may not prohibit a student from enrolling in more than five credit
15 hours; τ

16 (b) Shall require any student desiring to participate in an
17 extracurricular activity that is governed by a national or state
18 organization other than an athletics or activities association to be
19 enrolled only in the minimum number of credit hours offered by the school
20 district as required by such national or state organization in order to
21 participate in such extracurricular activity, but may not prohibit a
22 student from enrolling in more than such minimum credit hours;

23 (c) Shall not require any student desiring to participate in an
24 extracurricular activity that is not governed by a national or state
25 organization or an athletics or activities association to be enrolled in
26 any minimum number of credit hours offered by the school district in
27 order to participate in such extracurricular activity;

28 (d) Shall ~~shall~~ not allow any preference in the selection of a
29 student for participation in an extracurricular activity based on such
30 student's status as a full-time student in the school district; τ and

31 (e) May ~~(e) may~~ require any student participating in extracurricular

1 activities pursuant to such subsection to follow school policies that
2 apply to other students when present on school grounds or at a school-
3 sponsored activity or athletic event.

4 (4) Participation in extracurricular activities pursuant to
5 subsection (2) of this section shall not entitle a student to
6 transportation, except to and from practices and events to the same
7 extent as public school students participating in such activities, or
8 transportation reimbursement pursuant to section 79-611.

9 (5) ~~(4)~~ Nothing in this section shall be construed to exempt any
10 student from the compulsory attendance provisions of section 79-201 or
11 any statutes relating to habitual truancy.
