## Summary of Revenue and Expenses

For FY25, there was \$2,624,988.59 in revenue with \$1,319,310.26 in expenses. Expenses were as follows:

Personnel and Indirect Cost Rate	\$ 1,111,663.76
IT Systems and Contractual	\$ 61,898.50
Travel, including Conference Hosting	\$ 17,787.45
Supplies and Equipment	\$ 505.25
EMS Licensure Base Cost Charges	\$ 116,270.57
All Other	\$ 11,184.73

On net, \$1,305,678.33 was spent below total revenue. The Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) started planning for new activities in July 2025 and is in the process of finding vendors and securing contracts for education, training, and data requirements. Vacant positions resulted in personnel costs below expected expenses. These positions were posted and are in various stages of hiring and onboarding.
