- LB 296 *(Arch)* Require the State Department of Education to create a centralized education records system and employ registrars relating to students under the jurisdiction of the juvenile court and change provisions relating to graduation requirements and the State Department of Education Improvement Grant Fund
- LB 335 *(Conrad)* Redefine child under the In the Line of Duty Dependent Education Act
- LB 240 *(Jacobson)* Change certain notice provisions under the Community Development Law
- LB 293 *(Ballard)* Change provisions of the Professional Employer Organization Registration Act
- LB 609 *(Bostar)* Adopt the Controllable Electronic Record Fraud Prevention Act, require notice of potential fraud for purchasers of gift certificates and gift cards, and change provisions relating to search warrants

- LB 179 (*Clouse*) Change retirement contribution rates for police officers employed by cities of the first class
