- LB 311 *(DeBoer)* Adopt the Telecommunications Exchange Deregulation Act, restrict actions of governmental actors relating to telecommunications, and change provisions relating to regulation of telecommunications
- LB 198 *(Sorrentino)* Change provisions of the Pharmacy Benefit Manager Licensure and Regulation Act
- LB 521 *(Sanders)* Change and eliminate provisions relating to the Election Act, elections in cities of the metropolitan class and in cities of the primary class, and change notice requirements and exempt local foster care review boards under the Open Meetings Act

- LB 640 *(Judiciary Committee)* Change calculation of a sentence reduction for good behavior during confinement in a jail

- LB 32 *(Hunt)* Change provisions relating to disclaimers on political advertisements

GENERAL FILE: CONSENT CALENDAR

The following rules apply to Consent Calendar:

- 1) If any five members of the Legislature object to the bill being considered on Consent Calendar, please advise the Clerk in writing. Such requests must be filed with the Clerk prior to the reading of the bill, at this stage of consideration, on the bill to be removed.
- 2) Upon either the completion of debate or the expiration of 15 minutes, whichever comes first, a vote shall be taken to advance the bill and on any pending motions or amendments pursuant to Rule 5, Section 6(d).
- 3) Any amendment adopted, other than the standing committee amendment, which adds new subject matter to the bill will result in the bill not being scheduled at the next stage of debate.

- LB 371 *(DeBoer)* Provide liability for computer-generated images under the Uniform Civil Remedies for Unauthorized Disclosure of Intimate Images Act
- LB 490 *(McKeon)* Allow applications for certificates of title for certain agricultural vehicles
- LB 422 *(Storer)* Change provisions of the Nebraska Uniform Real Property Transfer on Death Act
- LB 499 *(DeBoer)* Change membership provisions relating to the Crime Victim's Reparations Committee
- LB 558 *(von Gillern)* Create the Infrastructure Review Task Force for the state highway system
