### SELECT FILE

LB 397 (*Moser*) Eliminate provisions relating to workplace safety committees and a workplace safety program and terminate a fund

LB 441 (*Spivey*) Authorize virtual inspections for certain building permits under the Building Construction Act

LB 794 (*DeKay*) Change powers and duties of the Department of Agriculture and eliminate provisions relating to the Healthy Soils Task Force and obsolete fund transfers

LB 717 (*Jacobson*) Adopt changes to federal law regarding banking and finance, change provisions relating to control of certain banks and trust companies, digital asset depository institutions, interest rates on certain loans, installment loans, mortgage loan originators, mortgage bankers, and the Nebraska Money Transmitters Act, and change references to the Nebraska Money Transmitters Act in the Controllable Electronic Record Fraud Prevention Act

LB 719 (*Jacobson*) Redefine a term under the Nebraska Rural Projects Act

LB 718 (*Jacobson*) Change provisions relating to examination, permit issuance, and disciplinary actions regarding certified public accountants

LB 202 (*Kauth*) Exempt certain activities from disciplinary action under the Medicine and Surgery Practice Act

LB 320 (*Sanders*) Require hotels and similar public lodging establishments to display posters relating to human trafficking, provide for training regarding recognition of human trafficking for employees of such establishments, and limit liability for human trafficking activity at such establishments

LB 663 (*Storer*) Require education for county attorneys, members of county planning commissions, and county board members and change provisions relating to conditional use or special exception zoning determinations and appeals

LB 103 (*DeBoer*) Change provisions relating to admissibility of evidence of past sexual assaults and the procedure for taking depositions of certain witnesses

LB 821 (*Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee*) Eliminate certain verification requirements performed by the Public Employees Retirement Board and change duties of the board and the Nebraska Investment Council relating to retirement systems

### GENERAL FILE: 2026 COMMITTEE PRIORITY BILL

LB 1001 (*General Affairs Committee*) Change and eliminate provisions relating to licensed racetrack enclosures, licenses and wagering on horseracing, assistance to problem gamblers, the Nebraska Commission on Problem Gambling, the Charitable Gaming Division of the Department of Revenue, keno at licensed racetrack enclosures, and the Compulsive Gamblers Assistance Fund

LB 720     (*Quick*) Create a temporary event license for body artists under the Uniform Credentialing Act

LB 745     (*Juarez*) Change provisions relating to the requirements for a diploma of high school equivalency

LB 940     (*Murman*) Prohibit certain color additives in school meals

LB 1022     (*Murman*) Eliminate the human relations training requirement for obtaining certificates and permits for teaching, providing special services, or education administration

LB 748     (*Sorrentino*) Change provisions relating to the Nebraska educational savings plan trust and allow for the use of trust funds for recognized postsecondary credential programs

LB 924     (*Andersen*) Change authorized uses of learning community levies

LB 956     (*Cavanaugh, J.*) Provide for the collection of postsecondary institution compensation data

LB 749     (*Sorrentino*) Change provisions relating to the calculation of tax levies for state aid to municipalities

LB 771     (*Ballard*) Change provisions relating to dynamic pricing used by transportation network companies
