

- LB 807 (*Ibach*) Eliminate the Riparian Vegetation Management Task Force and provisions relating to grants and provide for grants relating to weed management from the Water Resources Cash Fund
- LB 70 (*DeBoer*) Provide for adoption by a second adult person and change provisions relating to adoptions
- LB 877 (*Hallstrom*) Designate certain substances as controlled substances under the Uniform Controlled Substances Act

  - LB 834 (*Kauth*) Change provisions relating to county assessors, the Property Tax Administrator, real property assessments, taxes levied in counties, delinquent taxes owed to counties, remission of sales and use taxes, and mobile homes
  - LB 883 (*Andersen*) Change provisions relating to the Civic and Community Center Financing Act and the Revitalize Rural Nebraska Grant Program
  - LB 797 (*Urban Affairs Committee*) Increase minimum bidding amount requirements for certain cities and villages
