FINAL READING (Bills Preceded with an * Will Require a Vote To Suspend At Large Reading, Pursuant to Rule 6, Section 8)

- LB 103 *(DeBoer)* Change provisions relating to admissibility of evidence of past sexual assaults and the procedure for taking depositions of certain witnesses
- LB 202 *(Kauth)* Exempt certain activities from disciplinary action under the Medicine and Surgery Practice Act
- * LB 320 *(Sanders)* Require hotels and similar public lodging establishments to display posters relating to human trafficking, provide for training regarding recognition of human trafficking for employees of such establishments, and limit liability for human trafficking activity at such establishments
- * LB 397 *(Moser)* Change and eliminate provisions relating to workplace safety committees and a workplace safety program and terminate a fund
- LB 441 *(Spivey)* Authorize virtual inspections for certain building permits under the Building Construction Act
- * LB 663 *(Storer)* Require education for county attorneys, members of county planning commissions, and county board members and change provisions relating to conditional use or special exception zoning determinations and appeals
- * LB 717e *(Jacobson)* Adopt changes to federal law regarding banking and finance, change provisions relating to control of certain banks and trust companies, digital asset depository institutions, interest rates on certain loans, installment loans, mortgage loan originators, mortgage bankers, and the Nebraska Money Transmitters Act, and change references to the Nebraska Money Transmitters Act in the Controllable Electronic Record Fraud Prevention Act
- * LB 718 *(Jacobson)* Change provisions relating to examination, permit issuance, and disciplinary actions regarding certified public accountants
- * LB 719e *(Jacobson)* Redefine a term under the Nebraska Rural Projects Act
- * LB 794 *(DeKay)* Change and eliminate provisions relating to the Healthy Soils Task Force, require the Department of Agriculture to submit related documentation, and provide powers to natural resources districts regarding soil and water practices
- * LB 821 *(Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee)* Eliminate certain verification requirements performed by the Public Employees Retirement Board and change duties of the board and the Nebraska Investment Council relating to retirement systems
