- LB 548 (*Lippincott*) Authorize certain cities and villages that own or operate natural gas systems to contract with industrial consumers of natural gas
- * LB 70 (*DeBoer*) Provide for adoption by a second adult person and change provisions relating to adoptions
- LB 110 (*Hughes*) Provide requirements for intimate examinations of certain body parts
- * LB 653 (*Murman*) Change provisions relating to acceptance of students under the enrollment option program and discipline of students under the Student Discipline Act
- LB 741 (*McKinney*) Change the membership of the Racial Profiling Advisory Committee and the Nebraska Children's Commission

- * LB 877 (*Hallstrom*) Designate certain substances as controlled substances under the Uniform Controlled Substances Act
- * LB 795 (*DeKay*) Designate bromazolam as a controlled substance under the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, correct the spelling of certain controlled substances, and enhance penalties for certain controlled substance offenses involving fentanyl

- LB 1235 (*General Affairs Committee*) Change and transfer provisions of the Nebraska Medical Cannabis Patient Protection Act and the Nebraska Medical Cannabis Regulation Act and provide for taxation
- LB 1155 (*Dorn*) Change provisions relating to legislative oversight

- LB 985 (*DeBoer*) Provide a limitation on the number of individuals for which a guardian or conservator may accept appointment
- LB 835 (*Jacobson*) Change and eliminate provisions relating to fees of the Secretary of State, notices of liens under the Uniform Federal Lien Registration Act and the Uniform State Tax Lien Registration and Enforcement Act, the central filing system, effective financing statements, the master lien list, and filed records under the Uniform Commercial Code
- LB 1205 (*Clouse*) Require the Department of Economic Development to award grants under the Business Innovation Act
